ORGANIZATION

I co-founded Agitators Collective, a collaborative project, in 2006. Agitators Collective creates site related installations in urban locales that have fallen into neglect or dereliction in Jersey City. In Agitators Collective, ideas are freely shared and labor evenly distributed. We specifically choose materials and objects that capture the culture of Jersey City, such as candy from the corner bodega, Christmas lights from a 99cent store on Newark Avenue, and found objects taken from a vacant lot underneath an overpass. The locations we choose are either overrun with commuter traffic or in remote corners of the city.
